10.30 am - 11.30 am - Namasangeerthnam by Shri Udailyalur Kalyanaraman




11.45 am – 12.45 pm - "Villu Pattu" by Smt. Bharathi Thirumagam and group

School reopened for all the classes on 17.6.2022 except Class XI.


Yoga Day activities conducted from classes IV to XII. All our school students enthusiastically participated.
