Courses offered:

- Bharatanatyam
- Carnatic Music – Vocal
- Carnatic Instrumental - Veena / Violin / Mridangam
- Painting
- Clay modelling

“Parents should note that the Pratama classes are conducted only by **Offline mode (Direct Classes) at the Kalakshetra foundation campus.**” Class timings will be strictly adhered to and request for change will not be entertained.

i) Age Criteria:

Children between 7 years of age and 17 years of age only will be admitted. The age will be calculated as on 1st July 2023.

ii) Class timings:

One hour per class from 4.30 pm to 5.30 pm on the following days:

Bharatanatyam	Monday, Wednesday, 1 st and 3 rd Friday
Carnatic Music and & Instruments	Tuesday, Thursday, 2 nd and 4 th Friday
Visual Arts	Tuesday, Thursday, 2 nd and 4 th Friday

The parents are expected to drop their ward at least 10 minutes before the commencement of classes at the Kalakshetra campus.
