(I) INSTRUCTIONS TO THE TENDER:

- 1. The intending bidder must read the terms and conditions carefully. He/she should only submit has bid if he/she considers himself eligible and he/she is in possession of all the documents required.
- 2. The enlistment of the contractors should be valid on the last date of submission of tenders. In case only the last date of submission of tender is extended, the enlistment of contractor should be valid on the original date of submission of tenders.
- 3. The intending bidder must have registered in the appropriate class in CPWD/State PWD / Railway /MES/BSNL/Reputed Central or State PSUs / Autonomous Body / similar govt. agencies undertaking construction work.
- 4. The sealed envelope must be super scribed "ATTENDING INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL PAINTING WORKS ALONG WITH CIVIL REPAIR WORKS TO CERC MAIN BUILDING AT KALAKSHETRA FOUNDATION, THIRUVANMIYUR, CHENNAI- 41. with tender inquiry number and its due date.
- 5. The tender document should be filled in English and all entries should be typewritten or handwritten but there should not be any overwriting or cutting. Corrections, if any, shall be made by neatly crossing out, initialling, dating and rewriting.
- 6. The price/rate quoted should be indicated in words as well as in figures. If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the lesser amount shall be considered as valid. If the tenderer does not accept the correction of the errors, the bid shall be rejected.
- 7. All pages provided in the tender document shall be numbered and submitted as a package along with forwarding letter on agency's/firm's letter head with signed and sealed before their submission.
- 8. Rates should be quoted as shown in format schedule and all applicable taxes and duties levied by government should be clearly mentioned by tenderer separately.
- 9. Tenders qualified by such vague and indefinite expressions such as "subject to prior confirmation", "subject to immediate acceptance" etc. will be treated as vague offers and rejected accordingly.
- 10. The instructions given herein will be strictly binding on the tenderers and deviation, if any, not acceptable to the Kalakshetra Foundation, will make the tender or tenders liable to be



considered invalid. Tender(s) incorporating additional conditions by the tenderer(s) are liable for rejection.

- 11. At any time, prior to the date of submission of bids, Kalakshetra Foundation for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to clarification(s) sought by prospective bidders, may issue clarifications by amending the bid documents. All such amendments shall be notified and intimated by e-mail to all the tenderers. All such amendments have to be considered as mandatory constituent part of the tender document.
- 12. The tenderers shall fill up the (Part I) in prescribed format and submit the same duly signed on all pages and sealed as a token of their acceptance. Incomplete tenders i.e. "Part-I" without all the supporting documents, EMD and duly filled in, copy of valid trade license, copy of contract registration, Copy of GST registration & PAN.NO certificate, Address proof of the firm signed and stamped with official seal in all the pages will be rejected straightway without any reference to the tenderers.
- 13. The tenderers shall quote their rate in percentage above or below the cost mentioned in the schedule of quantities (Financial Bid) and submit the same duly signed and sealed. Overwriting in the Financial Bid is not permitted and shall be rejected straightway without any further reference.
- 14. Conditional tenders shall not be accepted.
- 15. Tenders submitted via electronic transmission or through e-mail shall not be accepted.
- 16. In case the last date of receipt/opening of tender is declared as a holiday, the tenders shall be opened on the next full working day.
- 17. The authorities of Kalakshetra Foundation do not bind themselves to accept mere lowest tender and reserves the right to reject or accept any or all tenders wholly or partially without assigning any reason whatsoever.
- 18. The bids shall be valid for a period of 45 days from the date of opening of the tender.
- 19. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with tenders is strictly prohibited and the tenders submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable to rejection.
- 20. Tender is not transferable. One tenderer shall submit only one tender.



- 21. Tenderer signing the tender must clearly, specify whether he/she is signing as Sole Proprietor, Authorized person, Partner, under Power of Attorney or as Director/Manager/Secretary etc., as the case may be.
- 22. In case the tenderer fails to submit any of the required documents as per tender document or found unsuitable to execute the tendered job shall not be considered and shall be rejected straight away without any further reference.
- 23. The successful contractor shall not transfer wholly or partially the order of work to any other person(s) / firm / company for any reason whatsoever and in which case the order shall automatically stand cancelled.
- 24. Tender document submitted by the participants should be concise and contain only relevant information as required under this tender.
- 25. The participant would be responsible for all of its expenses, costs and risks incurred towards preparation of the tender document, attending any pre-bid meeting and visiting the site or any other location in connection therewith. Kalakshetra Foundation shall, in no case, be responsible or liable for any such costs whatsoever, regardless of the outcome of the tender process.
- 26. The items involved are as per the schedule of quantities enclosed.
- 27. Specifications to be followed for execution of work for Civil Work: CPWD specifications 2019 Vol. I to II with up to date correction slips.

(II) GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The successful tenderer shall start work immediately from the date of award of work. The duplicate copy of the award letter duly signed with official stamp on all the pages to be submitted as a token of acceptance of the order.
- 2. The contractor shall also arrange for proper storage of the accessories at site and will be responsible for their watch ward.
- 3. Taking all precautionary measures to safeguard against any accident for the contractors employees, general public, supervisory staff of KF by providing necessary safety equipments e.g.



MS sheet barricading etc and Personal Protection Equipments e.g. helmets, safety shoes etc. at work site.

- 4. The site of work shall always be kept neat and clean and all building rubbish shall be periodically removed from the premises to avoid nuisance to occupants. All machines, equipments and labour for this purpose will be arranged by contractor.
- 5. All precautions not to damage the KF property shall be taken by the contractor. If any damage is caused to any structure etc. the same shall be made good by the contractor at his cost to the satisfaction of KF authority.
- 6. No payment will be made to the contractor for damage caused by rains during the execution of the works and no claim on this account will be entertained.
- 7. The work shall be carried out using metric dimensions only and shall be measured and paid in metric dimensions. F P S units, if any, mentioned in drawings etc are for guidance only.
- 8. Wherever any reference to any Indian Standard Specification occurs in the documents relating to this contract the same shall be inclusive of all amendments issued there to or revision thereof if any, up to the date of receipt of tenders.
- 9. Unless otherwise specified in the schedule of quantities the rates for the various items are for all heights and locations.
- 10. Unless otherwise specified in the schedule of quantities the rate for the items of the work shall be considered, as inclusive of pumping out or bailing out water, if required, for which no extra payments will be made. This will include water encountered from any source, such as rains, floods, sub-soil water table being high or due to any other cause whatsoever.
- 11. The tenderer shall study the item description, the relevant drawings and satisfy him the item of work to be carried.
- 12. If a tenderer quotes nil rates against each item in item rate tender or does not quote any percentage above/below on the total amount of the tender or any section/sub-head in percentage rate tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as lowest tenderer. Rates mentioned in financial bid in this percentage tender should not be altered.
- 13. The contractor shall produce the copy of the current validity of the BIS certification of the agency from whom materials was procured by the contractor. BIS marked materials shall



also be got tested. The materials and the quantity for which tests to be conducted shall be decided by the KF authority.

- 14. The contractor shall take instructions from the KF authority for stacking of materials in any place. No excavated earth or building material shall be stacked on areas where other buildings, roads, services compound walls are to be constructed.
- 15. Some restrictions may be imposed by the security staff etc., on the working and for movement of labour, materials etc. The contractor shall be bound to follow all such restrictions/instructions and nothing extra shall be payable on this account. The Contractor shall make necessary arrangement to obtain photo id pass / group pass for entry of labours, materials, machinery and vehicle in to the KF campus., Chennai.
- 16. The contractor shall take all precautions to avoid all accidents by exhibiting necessary caution boards and by providing red flags, red lights and barriers. The contractor shall be responsible for any accident at the site of work and consequences thereof.
- 17. It shall be deemed that the contractor shall satisfied himself as to the nature and location of the work, transport facilities, availability of land for setting up of camp etc. The KF will bear no responsibility for lack of such knowledge and the consequences thereof.
- 18. The above scope of work includes cost of all materials, manpower, equipments, T&P fixtures, accessories, royalties, taxes, watch & ward and all other essential elements for completion and maintenance of works as aforesaid whatsoever.
- 19. All labour employed by the firm/ contractor shall be got registered with Tamil Nadu Construction Labour Welfare Board, ESIC and EPF, etc.,
- 20. No work shall be done after 6 P.M. Due to exigencies of work, if work needs to be done beyond 6 pm, necessary prior permission shall be obtained from the Department. The work shall be executed without creating disturbance to the movement of the people on the adjoining roads. Care shall be taken to prevent dust spreading beyond the building to be demolished. The work shall be executed without making heavy sounds.
- 21. The work shall be executed in compliance with the complete labour act in force, regarding payment of minimum wages, advances, over time, gratuity, provident fund, providing medical and other facilities and the safety measures to be taken as applicable as per the labour act.
- 22. The Contractor shall carry out the work without disturbing / damaging the other existing structures and trees / plants etc which are not in the purview of the contract. Any damage /



disturbance made by the contractor to the adjacent / nearby buildings / structures will be rectified at the risk and cost of the contractor.

- 23. The contractor shall ensure the safety of the public / animals etc during the execution of the work. Necessary precautionary measures shall be taken.
- 24. Inserting of bare wires for tapping the power from electrical sockets is completely prohibited.
- 25. All unsafe conditions, unsafe acts identified by contractor, reported by site supervisors and / or safety personnel to be corrected immediately.
- 26. No children shall be allowed to enter the work space.
- 27. Water Supply: The Contractor has to make his own arrangements for water required for the work at work sites. If the supply is arranged by the KF, 1% of the value of the work done will be recovered from final bill.
- 28. Electrical Power: The Contractors will have to make their own arrangements for drawing electric power from the nearest power line after obtaining permission from the TNEB at his own cost. If the supply is arranged by the KF, necessary Tariff rates shall have to be paid based on the actual consumption.
- (III) General Terms of payment: -
- 1. The rate quoted should be percentage.
- 2. Tender should be submitted in sealed cover along with the Earnest Money of Rs.60,000/-(Rupees sixty thousand only). The EMD is to be furnished in the form of Account Payee Demand Draft/ Fixed Deposit Receipt /Banker's cheque/BG from any of the schedule bank/ Nationalised Bank drawn in favour of KALAKSHETRA FOUNDATION payable at Chennai. In case of entities exempted from EMD, certificate may be furnished. EMD in any other form will not be accepted as valid EMD.
- 3. EMD submitted by other bidders will be returned within 15 days after the award of contract. No interest will be paid on the Earnest Money deposited with the Kalakshetra Foundation. Earnest Money deposit in respect of the successful tenderer will be refunded on submission of



performance guarantee or will be adjusted towards performance guarantee on submission of difference of amount. If the successful tenderer fails to execute the order strictly as per the terms and conditions of the tender, EMD shall be forfeited forthwith after cancellation of the concerned order.

- 4. **Performance Guarantee:** Within two days of receipt of the Letter of Acceptance, the successful Bidder shall submit Performance Security @ 5% (five) of the total tender value.
- 5. This Security deposit will not bear any interest of whatsoever. This security deposit is to be furnished in the form of Account Payee Demand Draft/ Fixed Deposit Receipt /Banker's cheque, Bank Guarantee from any of the Nationalized Banks or from any one of the scheduled banks valid for a period of six months.
- 6. After successful completion of the contract, the Performance Security/guarantee amount will be refunded with final bill after adjusting dues if any to the KALAKSHETRA FOUNDATION from the Contractor subject to terms and conditions as per tender document.
- 7. The security deposit will be forfeited in case of breach of contract, Deduction of any dues payable to KF on whatsoever account, Deduction of any liability/damages incurred by KF, on behalf of the Service Provider/Contractor in the discharge of his/their obligations under this Tender.
- 8. No advance/part payments shall be released. Payment to the successful contractor will be paid at the end of successful completion of work on submission of final bill of quantities (BOQ) along with detailed measurements. Payments will be made either by cheque or RTGS/NEFT within 10 (Ten) working days only after the satisfactory completion of work.
- 9. 5% (five) Retention amount on the total value of work will be deducted at the time of passing the bills. The retention amount withheld by KF will be returned at the end of defects liability period of one year. No interest will be paid for the retention amount.
- 10. Income Tax, GST whichever is applicable at the prevailing rates as applicable from time to time shall be deducted as per extant rules. Quoted rates shall be inclusive of applicable GST. Failing which it shall be presumed that the prices include all such charges and no claim for the same will be entertained.
- 11. Revision of rates will not be permitted for any reason including during the extended period.
- 12. In the event of failure of work action will be taken to rescind the work and the work will be get through other agencies at contractor's risk and cost.

- 13. Deduction of any liability/damages incurred on behalf of the Service Provider/Contractor in the discharge of his/their obligations under this Tender.
- 14. During the progress of work, the Contractor/representative shall remain in touch with the Kalakshetra Foundation authorities and ascertain from them whether any excess over sanctioned cost is anticipated and/or has already occurred.
- 15. Time of Completion: Time is the essence of the contract. If contractor fails to complete the work within 30days from the date of award of contract, Liquidated Damage (L.D.) @1% of actual contract amount per week shall be recovered from the bill of the successful tenderer subject to a maximum of 10% of the contract amount.
- (IV) Deviation limits to be mentioned:
 - a) Deviation Limit for works above plinth level 30%
 - b) Deviation Limit for items in earthwork Subhead of DSR or related items: 100%
- (V) In case of Extra / Substituted Item the rate is to be worked out as follows. In the case of Extra Item(s) being the schedule items (Delhi Schedule of Rates items), these shall be paid as per the schedule rate plus cost index (at the time of tender) plus/minus percentage above/ below quoted contract amount. Payment of Extra items in case of non-schedule items (Non-DSR items) shall be made as per the prevailing market rate.
- (VI) In the case of substituted items (items that are taken up with partial substitution or in lieu of items of work in the contract), the rate for the agreement item (to be substituted) and substituted item shall also be determined in the manner as mentioned in the following para. (a) If the market rate for the substituted item so determined is more than the market rate of the agreement item (to be substituted), the rate payable to the contractor for the substituted item shall be the rate for the agreement item (to be substituted) so increased to the extent of the difference between the market rates of substituted item and the agreement item (to be substituted). (b) If the market rate for the substituted item so determined is less than the market rate of the agreement item (to be substituted), the rate payable to the contractor for the substituted item shall be the rate for the agreement item (to be substituted) so decreased to the extent of the difference between the market rates of substituted item and the agreement item (to be substituted).



(VII) For Deviated Quantities in the case of contract items, substituted items, contract cum substituted items, which exceed the prescribed limits laid down, determine the rates on the basis of the market rates and the contractor shall be paid in accordance with the rates so determined.

(VIII) TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT: - The agreement/work order herein may be terminated at any time by either party by giving a written notice of 15days to the other party.

<u>ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS AND SPECIFICATION</u>:- The additional specifications given below are not substitute to CPWD specifications or IS specifications. These shall be read along with CP W D specifications or IS specifications.

- 1. The work shall be carried out using metric dimensions only and shall be measured and paid in metric dimensions. F P S units, if any, mentioned in drawings etc are for guidance only.
- 2. Wherever any reference to any Indian Standard Specification occurs in the documents relating to this contract the same shall be inclusive of all amendments issued there to or revision thereof if any, up to the date of receipt of bids.
- 3. Unless otherwise specified in the schedule of quantities the rates for the various items are for all heights and locations.
- 4. Unless otherwise specified in the schedule of quantities the rate for the items of the work shall be considered, as inclusive of pumping out or bailing out water, if required, for which no extra payments will be made. This will include water encountered from any source, such as rains, floods, sub-soil water table being high or due to any other cause whatsoever.
- 5. The bidders shall study the item description, the relevant drawings and satisfy him the item of work to be carried out.
- 6. The rates quoted by the contractor shall be taken as net and nothing extra shall be paid on any account i.e. cartage, GST and stacking at required place etc.
- 7. The dismantling wherever required shall be done in a manner so that no other portions of the building or its fixtures are damaged. If any damage done to the building it shall be made good by the contractor at his own cost and no claim what so ever shall be entertained on this account.
- 8. The malba/garbage generated at site due to construction activities shall be removed from the Site to the location specified by KF.
- 9. The contractor shall clean the site thoroughly by removing scaffolding, surplus materials, rubbish, equipments left out of his work and shall dress the site around the building to the complete satisfaction of the KF authority before the work is treated as complete.



- 10. The Contractor shall not stack building material / malba / muck/ rubbish on the land or road of the KF campus. The muck, rubbish etc. shall be removed periodically as directed by the KF authority, from the site of work.
- 11. All the materials like cement, sand & stone chips etc. shall be arranged by the contractor. No material will be issued from KF stores.
- 12. All the tools & safety arrangement will be arranged by the contractor.
- 13. The safety arrangement shall be made by the contractor as per site requirement at his own cost.
- 14. In case make of any equipment or material is not specified in the NIT, the decision of the KF-in-Charge in this regard will be final.
- 15.Before tendering, the contractor shall inspect the site of work and shall fully acquaint himself about the conditions prevailing at site, availability of materials, availability of land and suitable location for construction of godowns, stores and camp, transport facilities, the extent of lead and lifts involved in the work (over the entire duration of contract) including local conditions, as required for satisfactory execution of the work and nothing extra whatsoever shall be paid on this account.
- 16. The contractor shall at his own expense and risk arrange land for accommodation of labour, setting up of office, the storage of materials, erection of temporary workshops, and construction of approach roads to the site of the work including land required for carrying out of all jobs connected with the completion of the work. However, the departmental land, to the extent available may be allowed to be used for the purpose free of rent without accepting any responsibility for the delay, if any, on this account. The contractor shall have to abide by the regulations of the authorities concerned and the directions of the KF-in-charge for the use of the land available at the site of work. If during construction it becomes necessary to remove or shift the stored materials shed workshop, access roads, etc. to facilitate execution of any other work by any other agency, the contractor shall do as directed by the KF-in-charge and no claim whatsoever, shall be entertained on this account.
- 17. It shall be deemed that the contractor shall satisfied himself as to the nature and location of the work, transport facilities, availability of land for setting up of camp etc. The department will bear no responsibility for lack of such knowledge and the consequences thereof.
- 18. The contractor shall have to make approaches to the site, if so required and keep them in good condition for transportation of labour and materials as well as inspection of works by the KF-incharge. Nothing extra shall be paid on this account.



- 19. No payment will be made to the contractor for damage caused by rain, floods and other natural calamities whatsoever during the execution of the works and any damage to the work on this account shall have to be made good by the contractor at his own cost and nothing whatsoever 'shall be paid on this account.
- 20. The contractor shall maintain in good condition all work executed till the completion of the entire work entrusted to the contractor under this contract and nothing extra shall be paid on this account.
- 21. Any damages done by the contractor to any existing work or work being executed by other agencies shall be made good by him at his own cost.
- 22. The work shall be carried out in such a manner so as not to interfere/or effect or disturb other works being executed by other agencies, if any.
- 23. All the ISI marked products are acceptable as per CPWD specifications at all times subject to the necessary Technical evaluation and necessity Vis-à-vis work.
- 24. Samples of all materials, fixtures, fittings like flooring tiles, wall tiles, doors, windows, sanitary fittings, roofing sheets etc. shall be got approved in advance before placing order for them. Similarly samples of all works like fixing roofing sheets, flooring, plastering, painting etc. shall be prepared in advance and got approved from the KF-in Charge before taking up the work.
- 25. Approved make of materials for use- As per CPWD approved brands/makes.

ARBITRATION CLAUSE: - In the event of any dispute arising out of or in connection with this tender/contract/work order, whether during the subsistence of the contract or thereafter, the matter shall be referred to the Director, KALAKSHETRA FOUNDATION or any other officer nominated by the Director, KALAKSHETRA FOUNDATION for arbitration whose decision shall be final and binding on the parties. The proceedings before the Arbitrator would be governed by the provision of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The place of arbitration shall be Kalakshetra Foundation, Chennai.

The courts of Chennai will have exclusive jurisdiction for any issue/dispute arising out of or in connection with the contract including relating to the arbitration proceedings.
