Adai Documentation as part of CSR:

The CSR project funding is utilized for documenting adai designs of Smt. Rukmini Devi Arundale ,to weave the designs on textiles, and creating a directory for Rukmini Devi Design Directory. The project is for 3 years and proposes to document about 75 designs. So far about 28 adai designs have been completed and documented.
