1. CENTRAL OFFICE



3. THEATRE


- Kalakshetra has performed for Doordarshan India, Delhi special coverage on Kalakshetra Foundation on 17th August, 2021.

7. BESANT ARUNDALE SENIOR SECONDARY SCHOOL (BASS School)

- Class X results were finalized and uploaded and results were declared by CBSE on 03-08-2021 and we secured 100% result.
- CBSE organized a webinar series for teachers to give more insights into the NEP (National Educational Policy) and all our teachers attended the webinar
- The online teaching platform has been shifted from WebEx to Google Classroom from 12th August 2021 for classes I to VIII. Classes were held separately for all the classes.
- As part of 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav' our school organized Kalavarna, an Inter-School cultural fest which featured competitions based on life of freedom fighters. This was held in the 1st week of August, 2021. The Valedictory function and prize distribution was organized on 19th August, 2021 at Rukmini Arangam.
- The Tamilnadu Government proposed to reopen the schools for class IX to XII from 1st September 2021 onwards and received the SOP's.

8. BESANT THEOSOPHICAL HIGHER SECONDARY SCHOOL (BTHS School)

- Results register has been submitted to the DEO for the classes from I to IX std for the academic year 2020-21
- KALVI TV schedule circulated to all the teachers to follow the guidelines for online teaching.
- A staff meeting has conducted by the Correspondent and Counsellor for adopting the SOPs /protocols for reopening of the school on 1st September 2021.

9. CRAFT EDUCATION AND RESEARCH CENTRE (CERC)

- Weaving: Smt. Rukmini Devi Arundale's silk sari weaving is on-going and her cotton collection revival results are good. The cotton Weavers are introduced to cotton korvai weaving. The yarn used is khadi, and chemical vat dyes are to be used.
- Printing: Until two months back cheap power-loom fabric was purchased for printing purpose. Initiatives were taken to weave in-house and same was proposed to be used for printing. The work is in progress. For the first time silk that was woven in-house was also printed and the results are satisfactory.



- Painting: The work for the book and regular work in the unit is in progress.
 Further, the panels similar to the ones in Director's office are being done. The idea is to carry Kalakshetra Foundation's identity to the ABCD project at the Red Fort.
- **Indigo dyeing**: The gestation period of six months is over, there were hurdles and learning and the current vats resulted good. Land is earmarked and prepared for cultivation of Indigo plant for in-house production of raw material.
- **Effluent Treatment Plant**: The Effluent Treatment Plant was approved in the month of November 2020, and to begin with, the effluent water that was discharged to the ground and the bore water were sent for lab test to find the chemical components in water. The project is in active progress.
- It is proposed to celebrate 'Back to Khadi' as part of Gandhi Jayanthi celebrations and Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav by organizing a Khadi exhibition.
- The Director, KF and HoU, CERC attended a meeting at the office of "The Registry of Sarees", Bengaluru on 21st August 2021 regarding the book under preparation.
