The centre of the auditorium and the centre of the stage is considered as the centre of yagna kunda According to Rig Veda – the entire cosmos is the body of Purusha and according to Artharva Veda – the cosmic Purusha is abstracted as Skamba (Yuba). There are two centers in the Koothambalam. The site plan of the Koothambalam based on the principles mentioned in the Shilapashastras. The specific devatas for the specific directions are also incorporated. According to the idea of Smt.Rukmini Devi, as mentioned in Rig Veda and Shilpashastras the structure of the temple is considered as cosmic purusha. The site plan adopted from the shilpashastras as mandalas. Smt.Rukmini Devi clearly mentioned the Koothambalam is not merely another theatre but based on the Vastu Purusha Mandala.

Kalasams are made in pure copper and filled with grains as per the Shilpashastra. It is to be repaired by traditional artistes with utmost care. The inner wooden pole also examined by experts and replaced karangali wood.

The Concept behind the construction is that the koothambalam was constructed on the principles laid by Bharata mugi as an Indian tradition; Bharata muni conceived the concept of theatre from Vedas. The taittreya samhita and different Brahmanas clearly mention about the cosmological and philosophical truths behind the shape of the Vedic (yagna kundas). They even mention a word how to prepare the bricks for yagnas. The bricks itself considered as a female deity and every yagnas to be performed with a special prayer to these bricks. According to Satapata brahmana, the almighty as an unmanifested, indefinable, immeasurable by preparing the clay with Veda mantras. The clay converted into manifested form of God.

It was built in the style of Satapata brahmana with the total area of the theatre is 2000 sft (TO BE VERIFIED). It is a gallery type auditorium with the guest accommodation of around 600. The octagonal is the centre point. The centre point is expanding circles. Outside the auditorium, the dwaraplakas are placed at 6 feet in the main entrance.

The outer prakara, peripheral entries which is initially octagonal has to be changed to square shaped. Henceforth the surface area covered would be increased.

The landscaping in and around the Koothambalam has been planed to be re-done. The area rises

Based on the original concept- Two giant wheels about 4.5 feet diameter in stone with intricate carvings based on the concept of Koothambalam. Four horses in stone out of which two horses are pulling the giant wheel and remaining two installed in front of the stage Ashtadik gajas or eight cardinal elephants and Ashtadik nagas in stone.

The eight dik devatas are placed on the inner side of the eight walls at roof level:

As its known that the Koothambalam of Kalakshetra, which was inaugurated in the year 1985 and since its day of inauguration the structure was never altered or repaired. As per the policy decision taken by the management to install the stone sculptures of wheels, horses, elephants, railings and dwarapalas at Koothmabalam it is proposed by Sthapathi Sri.K.P.Umapathy Acharya's, the consultant for traditional architecture of Koothambalam renovation project, (Ref pg. no. 16) that M/s. Bhagaban Subudhi may be entrusted with the installation of sculpture.

Project Urgency

Since it has been a long time since the structure was renovated (since 1985) and the space is still in active use and the space being one of the revered performing space in the country it is suggested the project of renovation may be carried out at the earliest and moreover the number of quality traditional sculptors are dwindling and their service has become quite rare it is suggested that the installation of sculptures such as wheels, horses, elephants, railings and dwarapalas such as may be done at the earliest

Project Significance

Since Koothambalam is a structure with high artistic and traditional significance, the sculptures installed under such expert guidance of Sthapathi Sri.K..P.Umapathy Acharya and executed by M/s. Bhagaban Subudhi, a renowned sculptor from Orissa, would survive for longer period of time and the space could be put to effective use.

The note to works committee for approval of the increased value of Rs.4.10 lakh over the original awarded value of Rs.6.95 lakh is submitted on 3rd Aug 2011. Further inputs on the extra scope of work interms of numbers and description along with the payments mode is now submitted for approval.

As could be seen from table-1 (pg.117) the sand stone sculptures and carvings were awarded to Sri.Bhagaban Subuddhi as per the terms and conditions indicated in table-2 & 3 below.

The work order for the description of the work as suggested by the consultant was issued in 28th Mar 2011 and the payments were regularised taking into account the description of work as suggested by him.

Subsequently the description of the sand stone sculptures and carvings were revised based on the consultants suggestions for more aesthetic and traditional values which was received on 22nd June 2011 and accepted by Sri.Bhagaban Subudhi. 'The change management document' submitted separately as a booklet highlites the need, manner and the method of such change in the stone sculpture project and the resultant increase in cost. However, the sculptures as initially contemplated in the work order need to be given improvements as per the various suggestions received by the traditional sculptors. The reasons for the changes and the basis of such changes are separately discussed in the change management document dated 15th September 2011 (Kept separately in the booklet form). As could be seen from the document the changes proposed will add to the aesthetic quality of the sculptors without any changes of the overall renovation programme.

The issue of change of this sculptural design was discussed with the consultant as well as Shri. Bhagaban Subudhi. In his representation vide letter dated 28.07.2011 at page 108,109 he requested that these change would involve to additional cost of Rs. 4.10 Lakh, as additional for the sculpture and carving work based on the details briefed according to the tradition of Tamil Nadu, which are more complex than the original drawing sent to him. The calculation for additional cost towards labour for Rs.4.10 lakh is as below

In line with the renovation of Koothambalam, the Vaastu aspects of the structure, which was un-finished in the earlier days need to be reassessed. In order to adopt the Vastu value in the Koothambalam, Stapi Shri.K.P.Umapathy Acharya was nominated for the work as Hereditary Architect and Vastu consultant by the Foundation in October 2010.

Based on consultant advice, the sand stone sculpture and carving (made out of Orissa sand stone) items was awarded to Shri. Bhagaban Subudhi at a total cost of Rs.6.95 lakh with the details of items as specified in the Table 1 below and period of completion 60 days effecting working days.


